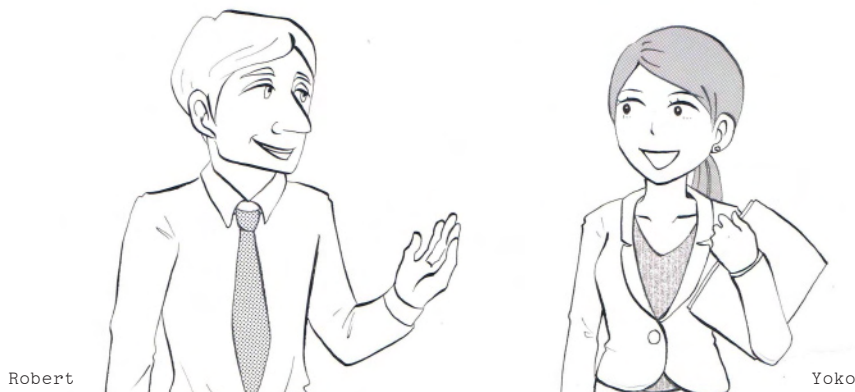
▶ アメリカをはじめ、学校の成績は A ~ F 評価のように英文字で分類される地域が多いです。A が一番良い成績です。
