auxiliary verb / should, had better

助動詞 should と had better

「should(~するべきだ、~したほうがいい)」、 といった義務や提案とほぼ同様の意味を持つ のが、「had better」です。この形のまま動詞(原 形)の前に置いて使いましょう。

「had better」は、より強いニュアンスがあり、 また警告的な意味を含んでいます。

「should」には、「(現時点) のはずだ」という意味もあります。

should not = shouldn't She had better = She'd better


