Passive Voice / verb used with adverb (expect 'by')

受動態/ by以外の前置詞をとる動詞

「~によって」は普通「by~」で表現しますが、「I was surprised at the news.(その知らせによって驚かされた/その知らせに驚いた)」のように、感情や状態などを表す動詞には「by」以外の前置詞を使うと自然です。

動詞と前置詞の組み合わせには相性があるので、練習して慣れましょう。


