時間情報を加えて話すときの「at/on/in」は、時間のピンポイントを示す「at」から、「on」、「in」、と順に長くなっていくイメージです。「during(~の間に)」、「for(~間)」、「until(まで:継続)」、「by(までに:期限)」 なども含めて練習しましょう。
