conjunction 接続詞

「although/ though ~ (~けれども/~でも)」 や「even if/even though ~ (たとえ~でも)」 は譲歩を表します。

接続詞の「since(~以来/~以降)」は「~ だから/~なので」と理由を示すときにも使われ、「while(~している間)」は「~けれども/~だが一方」という意味も持っています。 「unless」は条件を表し、「if ~ not/except that ~ (~でなければ、~でない限り)」という意味を持ちます。
