How about joining the mountain climbing this weekend?

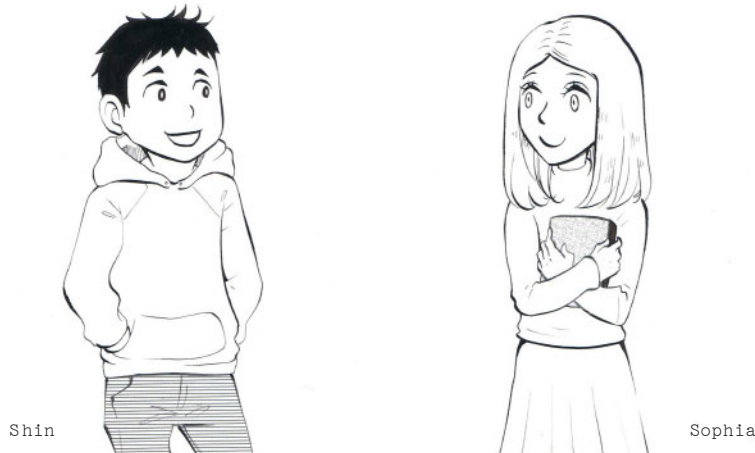
Answer
