Would you give a second thought on this proposal?

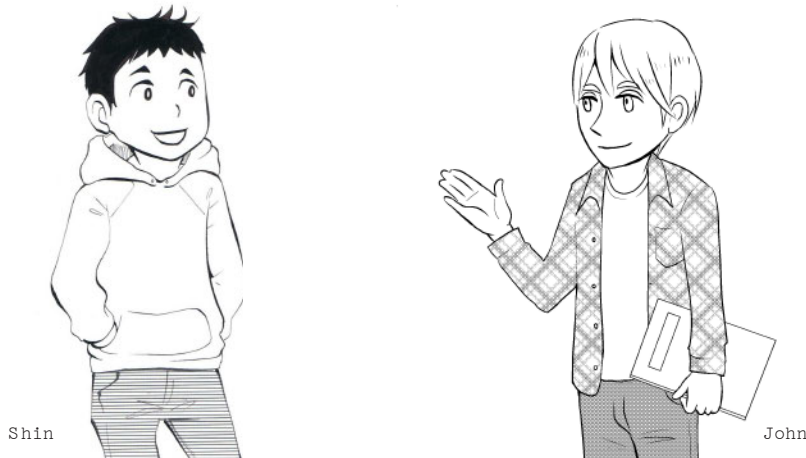
Answer
