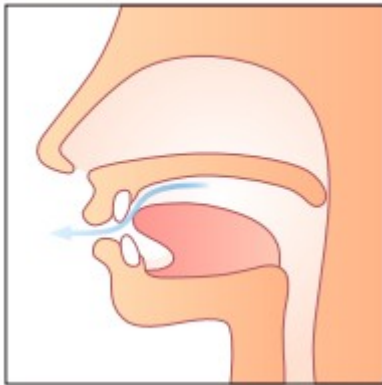


Practice 1 Phonetic Symbols

ʃ --- she /ʃi:/:/ (or /ʃi/)

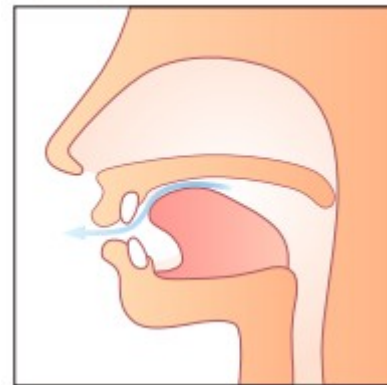
[s][z]



Put your tongue right behind your teeth, but not touching them.

gosh /gɑ'ʃ/

Some people say '**Gosh**' when they are surprised. | Exclamation | old-fashioned

- Gosh, there's a lot of noise.

sensitive /se'nsətiv/

If you are **sensitive to** other people's needs, problems, or feelings, you show understanding and awareness of them. | Adjective | approval

- The classroom teacher must be sensitive to a child's needs.

stand by /stæ'nd/

If you **stand by** someone, you continue to give them support, especially when they are in trouble. | Phrase | approval

- I wouldn't break the law for a friend, but I would stand by her if she did.

shake /ʃe'ik/

3. If you **shake** your head, you turn it from side to side in order to say 'no' or to show disbelief or sadness. | Verb

- 'Anything else?' Colum asked. Kathryn shook her head wearily.
